

RECORD OF SPECIAL BOND ELECTION ON BEHALF OF
FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT DISTRICT HELD ON
OCTOBER 27, 1953

I, Samuel B. Pinder, Sr., Supervisor of Registration of Electors and Raymond R. Lord, County Judge, met in the office of the Supervisor of Registration on the 28th day of October, A. D. 1953 and respectively submitted to the Board of County Commissioners the returns of the votes FOR and AGAINST, (together with the twenty-eight (28) absentee ballots), as hereinafter specified at the Special Bond Election on Behalf of the Florida Keys Aqueduct District held on October 27th, A.D. 1953, as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Registration, respectively, and we hereby certify solely and entirely from said returns as follows: The total number of votes cast were Two thousand three hundred and forty-four (2,344)

SHALL GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT DISTRICT, MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$14,000,000 BE ISSUED BY THE FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING CERTAIN EXISTING WATERWORKS FACILITIES NOW SERVING THE DISTRICT, RECONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, EXTENDING AND ENLARGING THE SAME AND CONSTRUCTING CERTAIN ADDITIONAL WATER SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES, SUCH BONDS TO BE PAYABLE FROM WATER RATES AND CHARGES AND UNLIMITED AD VALOREM TAXES, AND TO BE ISSUED AT ONE TIME OR FROM TIME TO TIME IN SERIES, TO BEAR INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES NOT EXCEEDING FIVE PER CENTUM PER ANNUM, AND TO MATURE OR THE BONDS OF EACH SERIES TO MATURE AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES NOT EXCEEDING FORTY YEARS FROM THEIR DATES, AS THE FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT DISTRICT COMMISSION SHALL HEREAFTER DETERMINE?
