

RECORD OF FIRST PRIMARY ELECTION
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1958

STATE OF FLORIDA

I, Wm. Billy Freeman, Supervisor of Registration of Electors of said County do hereby certify that the County Canvassing Board consisting of Clarence S. Higgs, County Commissioner, acting in absence of Raymond R. Lord, County Judge; Gerald Saunders, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and Wm. Billy Freeman, Supervisor of Registration of said County, met in the County Commissioners Chambers on the 10th day of September, A. D. 1958 at 8:00 P. M. and proceeded publicly to canvass the vote given for the offices and persons; together with the absentee ballots (372 ballots were mailed and voted in person) as hereinafter specified, at the first primary election held in said County on the 9th day of September, A. D. 1958 at which time all absentee ballots were challenged by Ralph E. Cunningham, Jr., his attorneys J. Lancelot Lester and M. Ignatius Lester also appearing at this meeting were J.Y. Porter, IV, his attorney W. Curry Harris and Paul E. Sawyer, County Attorney as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Registration, respectively. During the counting of these ballots several objections and challenges were made by the various attorneys present and rulings made by the Board. The results of the counting of said absentee ballots which were actually certified and counted by the Board to be true and good ballots were as follows: The total number of votes cast were Eight Thousand Three Hundred and Eighteen (8,318); the total number of electors qualified were Eleven Thousand Five Hundred and Forty-Four (11,544).
