Billy Freeman, Supervisor of Registration of electors of said County do hereby certify that the County Canvassing Board consisting of Helio Gomez, County Judge; Gerald Saunders, Chairman, Board of County Commissioners; and Wm. Billy Freeman, Supervisor of Elections of said County met in the office of the Supervisor of Elections on the 3rd day of November, A. D. 1965 at 10:00 A.M. and proceeded publicly to canvass the vote given for the offices as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Elections, respectively, together with the absentee ballots (131 ballots were mailed and voted in person, 1 absentee ballot was disqualified) and we hereby certify solely and entirely from said returns as follows; the total number of votes cast were Nine Thousand One Hundred and Sixty-Six (9,166); the total number of electors qualified were Twenty Thousand Three Hundred and Ninety-Eight (20,398)

M. and proceeded publicly to canvass the vote given for the offices as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Elections, respectively, together with the absentee ballots (106 absentee ballots were mailed and voted in person; 5 absentee ballots were disqualified for not being notarized) and we hereby certify solely and entirely from said returns as follows: the total number of votes cast were Seven thousand eight hundred and twenty-four (7,824); the total number of electors qualified were Eighteen thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight (18,858).

For the nomination of a Democratic candidate for Judge, District Court of Appeal, 3rd Appellate District, Group No. B, the whole number of votes cast was Two thousand nine hundred and seventy-six (2,976)
