Billy Freeman, Supervisor of Elections of said County met in the office of the Supervisor of Elections on the 15th day of March, A. D. 1967 at 10:00 A. M. and proceeded publicly to canvass the vote given for the offices as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Elections, respectively, together with the absentee ballots (10 absentee ballots for Democrats were mailed or voted in person) and we hereby certify solely and entirely from said returns as follows: the total number of votes cast were One thousand Eight hundred and Thirty-six (1,836); the total number of Republican electors qualified were Eight hundred and Forty-five (845); the total number of Democratic electors qualified were Eighteen thousand and eighteen (18,018)

For the nomination of a Republican candidate for State Senator 36th Senatorial District, the whole number of votes cast was One hundred and Four (104)
