WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, PAUL E. ESQUINALDO, COUNTY JUDGE, WM. BILLY FREEMAN, SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS, AND PURIEGTON HOWANITZ OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, CONSTITUTING THE BOARD OF COUNTY CANVASSERS IN AND FOR SAID COUNTY, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT WE MET IN THE OFFICE OF THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS ON THE 9TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D., 1977, AND PROCEEDED TO PUBLICLY CANVASS THE VOTES GIVEN FOR THE SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION HELD ON THE 8TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D., 1977, AS SHOWN BY THE RETURNS ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY JUDGE AND SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS RESPECTIVELY. WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY FROM SAID RETURNS AS FOLLOWS:

PROPOSAL

The Board of County Commissioners of Monroe County, Florida should levy ad valorem taxes in fiscal year 1978-1979 in District 5 not to exceed \$77,000 (or approximately 77¢ per each \$1,000 of assessed valuation of real property) to purchase one fire truck and one ambulance to be used in District 5.

The Board of County Commissioners of Monroe County, Florida should levy ad valorem taxes in fiscal year 1978-1979 in District 6 not to exceed \$133,372 (or approximately \$1.12 for each \$1,000 of assessed valuation of real property) to purchase two fire trucks and one ambulance to be used within District 6.
