QUESTION: "SHALL A SPECIAL HOSPITAL MUNICIPAL DISTRICT BE ESTABLISHED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE COMMUNITY OWNED MARINERS HOSPITAL FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING IMPROVEMENTS AND PAYING DEBT; TO BE FUNDED BY AN AD VALOREM TAX OF ONE-HALF MILL (\$.0005) ON THE TAXABLE REAL PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT WHICH IS THAT AREA FROM THE CHANNEL 5 BRIDGE NORTH TO THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NORTH KEY LARGO BEACH, EXCLUDING OCEAN REEF CLUB AND THE MAINLAND PORTION OF MONROE COUNTY."
